



Form flowers are flowers that have very distinctive shapes....If you put a light on one side of them, they would cast very easy to recognize shadows...(the main event in many floral designs).



Mass flowers are form flowers that are solid, usually rounded and fill space easily in a floral design.



Linear flowers are long flowers... The individual flowers work their way down a stem, allowing your eyes to follow them from the top to the bottom....



Filler flowers are flowers usually found in branch like groups or clusters, often very, very small, that are used to 'fill in' in between larger flowers in a floral design.
