Technically, if we follow the dictionary definition of the term, anything that is being stylized at the present time could be said to be "contemporary," but that is not what floral designers usually mean by the term. When we call a design "contemporary" we usually mean something that is "cutting edge" or "bleeding edge." Something that is unusual, different and perhaps a bit wild. Certainly not anything classical or conservative that Grandfather or Dad
